

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE**1. COAT THE PACK**

Coat the leading edge of the ear pack with an antibiotic ointment or lubricant for ease of insertion. If applicable, trim drawstring to desired length. Ear Pack may be trimmed to size if required.

2. INSERT

Grasp the ear pack with forceps. Hold the external canal open with a speculum and advance the pack into the external canal. Gelfoam or antibiotic ointment may be inserted first. Instill antibiotic ointment generously around the side of the pack, leaving the proximal end uncoated for hydration.

3. EXPANSION

Hydrate the outer end of the ear pack with saline, sterile water or antibiotic drops until fully expanded.

4. REMOVAL

Re-hydrate the pack until saturated (surgeons recommend allowing the pack to remain in place for 5 - 10 minutes after re-hydrate to facilitate removal). Use forceps to grasp the pack and gently withdraw.

IMPORTANT

Surgeons recommend instructing the patient to instill antibiotic drops onto the pack at least twice a day.

BE SURE TO RE-HYDRATE THE PACK BEFORE REMOVAL.
